

PROF. DOMENICO GRIMALDI AWARD

The Organization Committee and the Conference Organizing Secretariat of the “Opportunità in Medicina Interna: XXX Edizione” Conference has set up an award in commemoration of Prof. Domenico Grimaldi for his outstanding contribution in Medical Measurements and Applications field.

Domenico Grimaldi was a Full Professor of electronic measurement with the Department of Computer Sciences, Modelling, Electronics and System Science, at University of Calabria, Rende, Italy. He was responsible for the Laboratory for Processing the Measurement Information. He was responsible for the research unit in the frame of National Projects PRIN, FIRB, and international projects INTERLINK supported by the Italian Ministry for University and Research. He was responsible for the Tempus Project and Leonardo daVinci Project supported by the European Union. He was delegate of the Rector of the University of Calabria. From 1998 to 2000, he was an AEI Vice-President for the Calabria Region. He has authored or co-authored more than 230 papers published in international journals and conference proceedings. He was Senior Member of the Institute of Electrical and Electronic Engineers (IEEE), a member of the Italian Institute of Electrical Engineers and Italian Group of Electrical and Electronic Measurements (GMEE). He was the coordinator of the GMEE research track: “measurements for human and environment”. His outstanding contribution in the measurements for human health was recognised by the scientific community with several national and international prizes and honours.

The Award will be given for the “Best Doctoral Thesis or Journal Paper” presenting innovative research results in the field of medical measurements and applications and it consists, in addition of a Plaque, an honorarium, all inclusive, of €5000,00 (gross). In particular, the proposed research must concern with measurement in medical field, and can take into account one or more aspects of interactions among the world of the instrumentation and measurement and the medical field.

The PhD Thesis must have been discussed in year 2018 or 2019. The journal paper must have been published in year 2018 or 2019.

Candidates must send their application by **April 30th, 2019** together with:

- electronic copy in pdf format of the Ph.D. Dissertation/Journal Paper with a 1-page summary of it;
- Curriculum Vitae listing educational background, positions held, publications, awards, etc.

The candidates will be evaluated by May 15th, 2019 by a Board of three Experts in Medicine, Engineering, Measurement designated by the Conference Committee.

Notices to the winners will be mailed by May 20th, 2019.

A presentation of the results presented in the PhD thesis/Journal Paper will be presented at “Opportunità in Medicina Interna: XXX Edizione” Conference. The award must be received by the winner in person during the conference. No award will be given in absentia, except under extraordinary circumstances, as determined by the Award Committee.

All the decisions of the Board are final. No ex-aequo is allowed.
